89-91 Points

**Maison Louis Jadot Côte d'Or Burgundies
Beaune Clos des Couchereaux Premier Cru 2011**


Notes of menthol and cool cherry aromas slides gracefully into supple, vibrant and attractively rich and mineral-driven middle weight flavors that possess a lovely mouth feel thanks to the relatively fine-grained tannins. Despite their fine grain, the admirably long finish is notably firm and this will require most of a decade to arrive at its peak.

**Maison Louis Jadot Côte d'Or Burgundies
Beaune Clos des Ursules Premier Cru 2011**


A toasty nose of red and black cherry, spice, earth and a hint of game merges into cool and pure middle weight flavors that display a subtle trace of minerality. There is a firm but not hard tannic spine shaping the delicious and moderately persistent finish that offers good if not truly special depth.

**Maison Louis Jadot Côte d'Or Burgundies
Beaune Grèves Premier Cru 2011**

A fresh and attractively ripe nose of wild red berries, violets and again, plenty of earth character. There is good energy to the round and supple medium weight flavors that possess a silky texture on the mid-palate before terminating in a delicious if not especially complex finish. Still, there is enough underlying material and an excellent track record for developing with age and thus my range offers the benefit of the doubt.

**Maison Louis Jadot Côte d'Or Burgundies
Beaune Premier Cru 2011**


There is a floral element to the wild red cherry and raspberry suffused nose that introduces very round, supple, forward and generous flavors that possess a seductively textured mid-palate. Firm and serious finish that retains a fine sense of balance.

Maison Louis Jadot Côte d'Or Burgundies Bonnes Mares Grand Cru 2011


A moderately toasty nose fights somewhat with the spicy plum, cassis, warm earth and game suffused aromas. There is a plush mouth feel to the big-bodied and muscular flavors that display a discreet minerality before terminating in a firm, vibrant and quite serious finish.

Maison Louis Jadot Côte d'Or Burgundies Le Chambertin Grand Cru 2011

Medium red. Very reduced nose hints at red currant, spices and sexy smoky oak. Lush and silky on the palate, with a compelling sweetness to the rich red fruit and soil flavors. Not yet showing much complexity, with the oak element dominating today, but communicates a sense of power that suggests this wine will benefit from further élevage and time in bottle.

Maison Louis Jadot Côte d'Or Burgundies Chambertin-Clos-de-Bèze Grand Cru 2011

“Don't Miss” Wine There is enough oak influence to notice though not enough to materially detract from the high-toned and overtly spicy red currant, cherry and plum suffused nose. There is a lovely minerality to the supple, forward and refined middle weight plus flavors that possess a wonderfully refined mouth feel before culminating in a long, powerful, concentrated and palate drenching finish.



92-94 Points

Maison Louis Jadot Côte d'Or Burgundies Chambolle-Musigny Les Amoureuses Premier Cru 2011

“Sweet Spot” Wine A spicy and notably floral nose of attractively layered aromas features notes of cassis, black cherry and plum aromas. There is a lovely mineral streak that runs the length of the refined medium-bodied flavors that possess excellent complexity, all wrapped in a balanced, lingering and lilted finish. I very much like the finesse and brilliant mouth feel as it's pure silk.



89-92 Points

Maison Louis Jadot Côte d'Or Burgundies Chambolle-Musigny Les Baudes Premier Cru 2011

As is almost always the case, the mouthfeel is less refined but more muscular with good power, volume and punch to the medium-bodied flavors that finish with excellent length. This should also amply reward up to a decade of cellar time.
