Pouilly-Fuissé Tête de Cru Les Perrières 2018

From a steep, mid-slope vineyard facing south-southeast, the vines planted in the early 1970s, this is earthy, bold chardonnay in a Mâconnais dialect. Its quiet, brisk complexity combines light greenapple crunch and buzzy honey-scented acidity, along with a darker tone—Berkshire sommelier Michael Kowalski described it as a grilled-fennel scent. Those flavors amplify as the wine opens to pale beauty.
