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LOUIS JADOT CÔTE D'OR BURGUNDIES

*Puligny-Montrachet Clos de la Garenne
Domaine Duc de Magenta 2018*

94 POINTS

Deliciously fresh in all its facets, from the appleblossom scents to the luscious pear flavors and the lasting tingle of limestone acidity, this wine excited our panel (and this critic) like no other Puligny in the tasting. Daniel Osman of the Dream Away Lodge in Becket, Mass., described the clarity of its freshness as “iron and silk—like drinking cold water out of a mountain stream.”

The wine gains its cool energy from the low yields of deeprooted old vines, some more than 80 years old. That energy seems to expand over the course of days, hosting scents of chamomile, the bacon fat and freshly cracked walnut tones of the

youthful presence of oak, raw honey, Meyer lemon, and tangerine.
